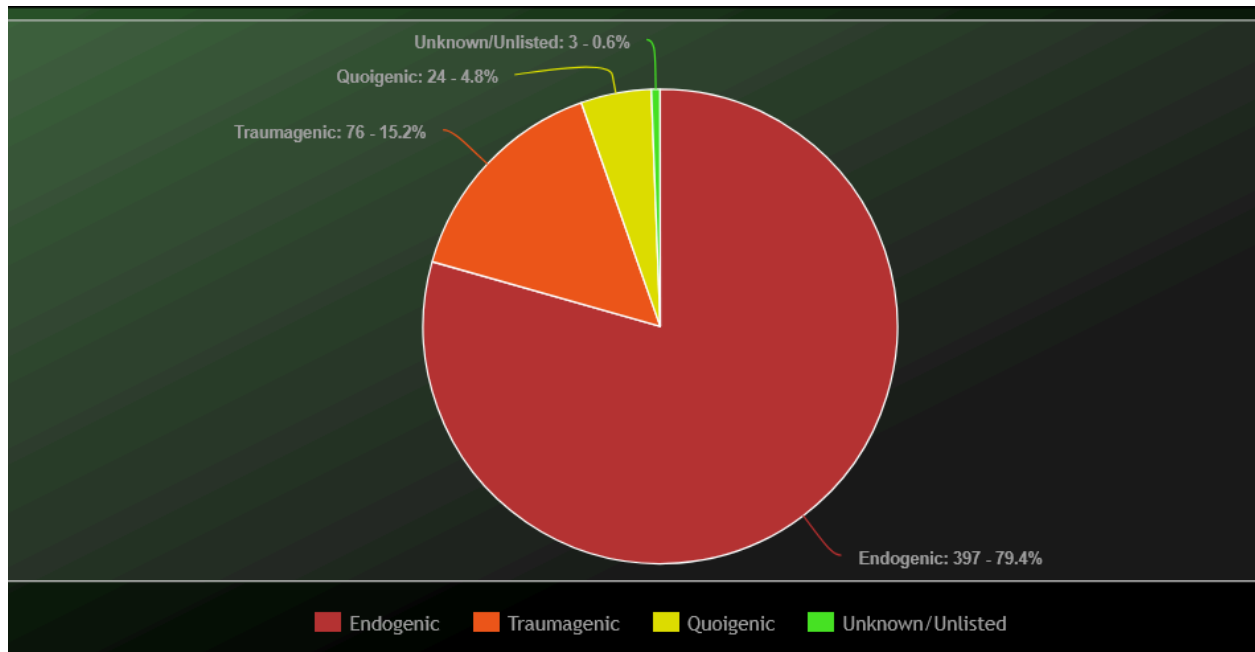

Point is: this is a bunch of pie charts displaying lots of stuff about our headmates and our system. This is public because we're fine with sharing it, and maybe having this idea will help other systems make something similar to help themselves. I know having this helps us, honestly just by having easily accessible information about ourselves.

This was done just as we reached 500 members. Sources are counted per identity, not per headmate. If a Sonic fictive also has a kintype from Sonic as a series, they count twice for Sonic as a source. If a person is from The Owl House and has an identity from another source too, they count as a point toward both. Hearttypes and linktypes and other identities are also counted, not just kintypes and introject identities.

Included are stats about: Our individual headmates origins, the "type" of headmates (e.g. tulpa, split), introject (or lack thereof) type, age and/or age range (or.. Lack thereof!), genders, romantic orientation, sexual orientation, if a headmate has roles or not, and what fictional source they're from.

As a quick disclaimer, we count origins as referring to *headmates* as opposed to whole system. We're not traumagenic or endogenic ourselves as a whole, but it makes more sense to point to specific headmates and use those labels for individuals!

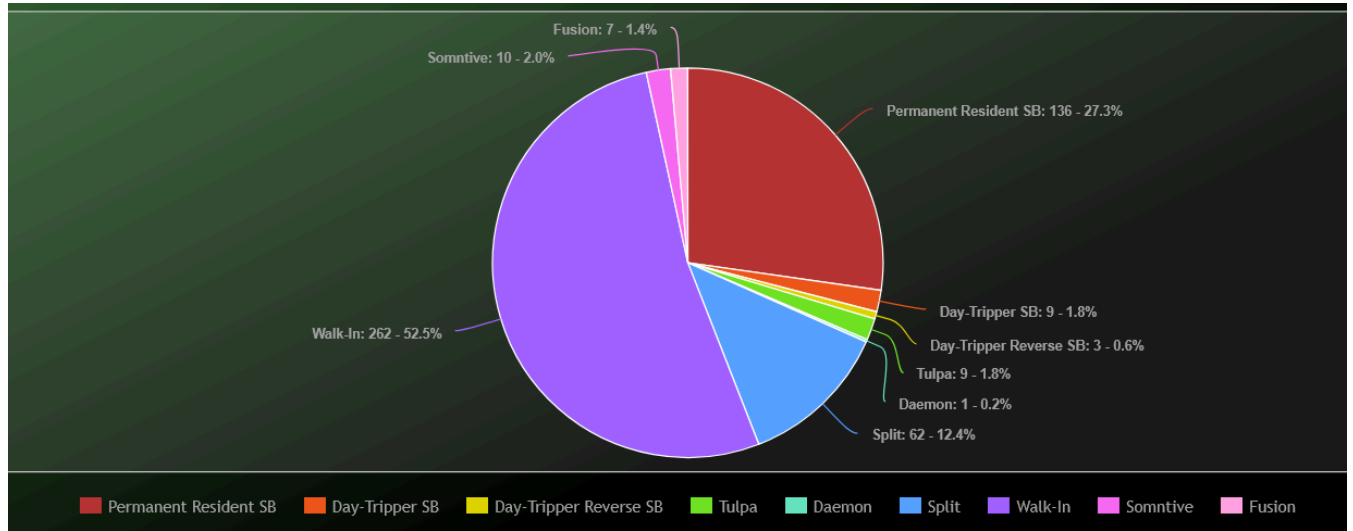

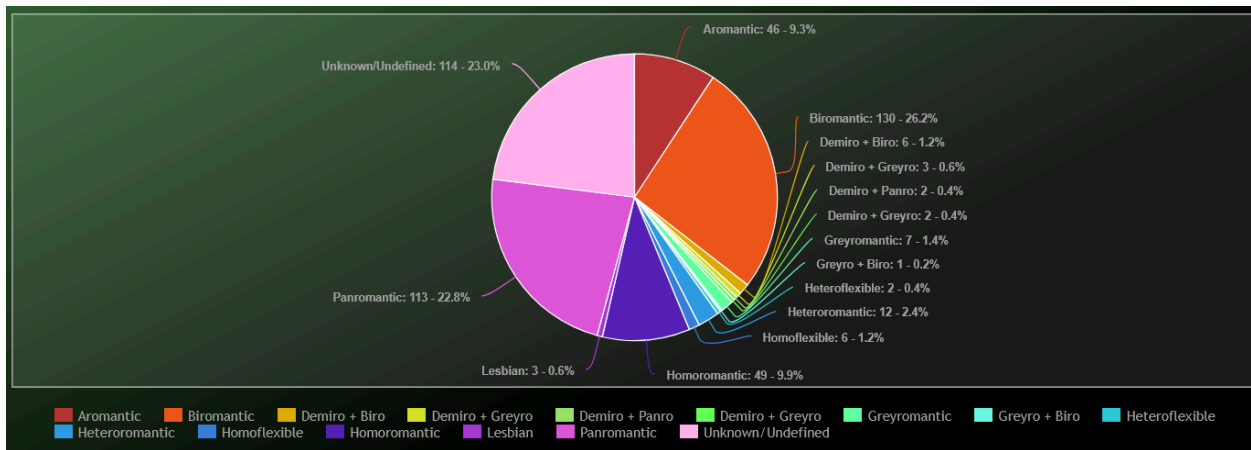

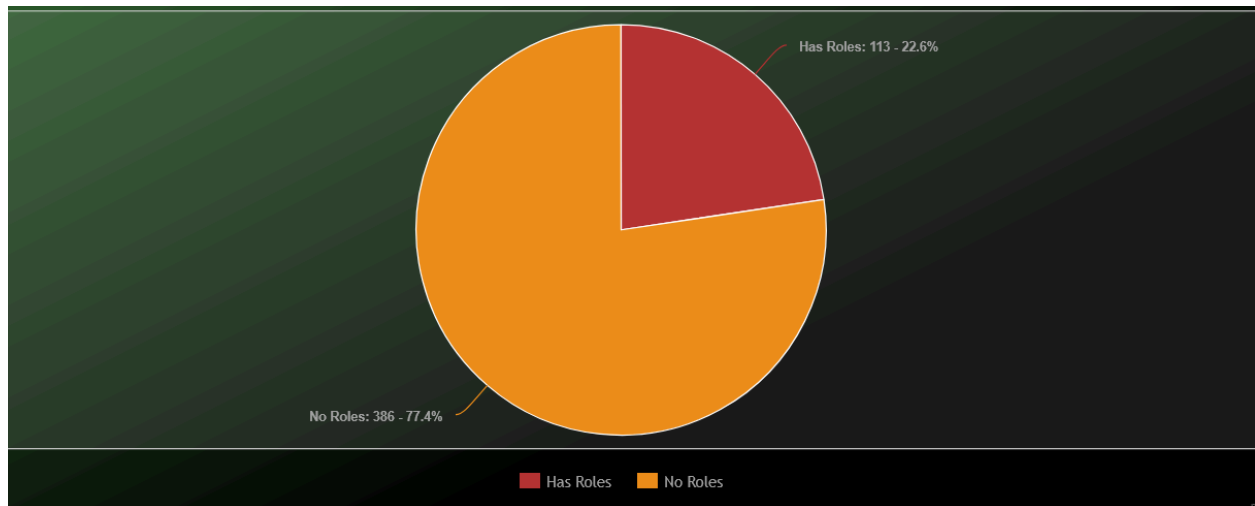

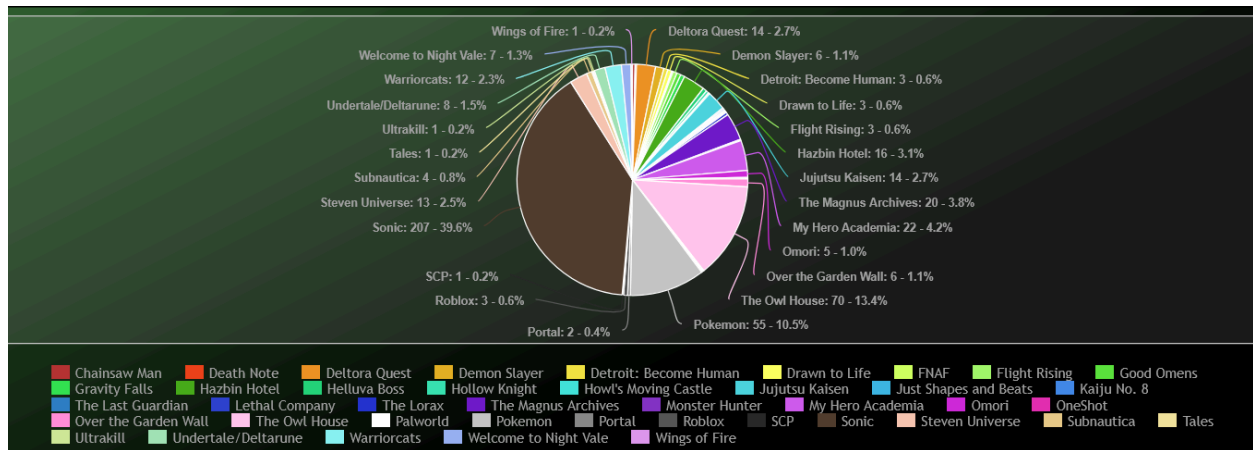
